MEETING MINUTES

The Conservation Commission of the Town of Southborough held a meeting on Thursday, August 23, 2007 at 7:30 p.m. at the Town House 2nd floor meeting room.

Members present: Richard Upjohn, Ann Leavitt and Phil Bevins.

Absent: Rhonda Russian, Mark Possemato, Louis Bartolini and John Leeds.

The meeting commenced at 7:30 p.m. with Richard Upjohn acting as chairperson.

Due to the lack of a quorum, the Commission was unable to hold the scheduled Fay School Stormwater Management Permit and Notice of Intent public hearings.

Mr. Upjohn read a letter into the record addressed to the Commission from David LaPointe of Beals & Thomas on behalf of Fay School that had been hand delivered to Ms. Rosenblum earlier in the day. It was a formal request seeking a continuance from the 8/23/07 meeting to the 9/13/07 meeting. The Commission members present agreed to grant the request, and the hearing was officially continued to 9/13/07 at 7:45 p.m.

Ms. Rosenblum distributed Fay School revised plans received earlier in the day.

Upon motion by Mr. Bevins, seconded by Ms. Leavitt, the Commission voted (3-0) to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 p.m.
